

ARTIFICIAL CACTUS INSTALLATION & PAINTING

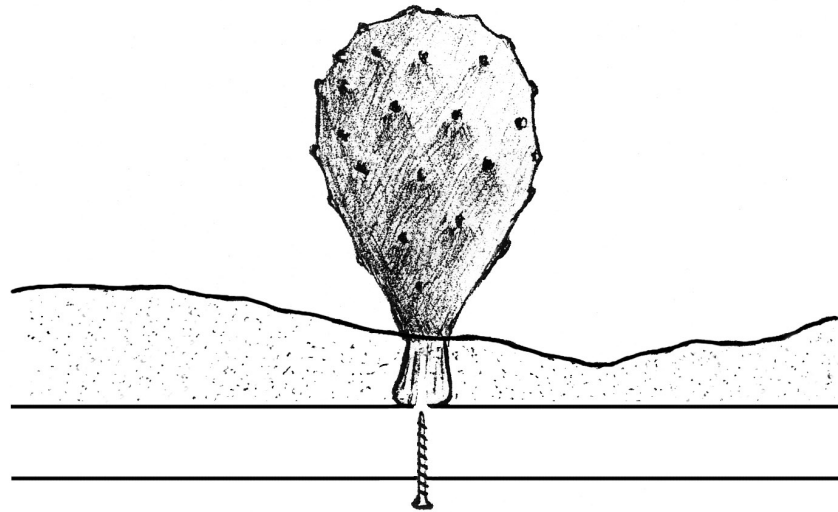
The artificial cactus was created to be attached to a base in the easiest way possible. Just follow these simple steps!

PROCEDURE:

1. Start by drilling a hole completely through the base where you want the cactus to stand, making sure that the hole is large enough so that the screw can slide through with ease.
2. Next, place the cactus leaf over the hole and run the screw up through the base into the existing hole in cactus until the stem is solid.
3. Finally, repair your habitat material around the stem to match the rest of your base habitat.

PAINING PROCEDURE:

1. Basecoat entire leaf with Yellow Ochre: X-303.
2. Mist Medium Green: X-402 over the entire leaf. (you'll want to see a shade of yellow through the green)
3. On the quills spots, use Dark Brown: X-203.
4. Brownish colored fishing line works well in achieving the look of natural quills. Cut the fishing line to length and then glue them on the brown quill spots. Use a quick set glue such as Zap-A-Gap: S-85 or Zap: S-86.
